

- God's Revealing of Himself to Mankind
 - o Natural Revelation—His World (v. 1-6)
 - o <u>Divine</u> Revelation—His <u>Word</u> (v. 7-14)

Psalm 20 and Psalm 21

- These two psalms go together
 - o Psalm 20—Prayer before the battle
 - o Psalm 21—Praise after the victory
- Psalm 20
 - Prayer for the King (v. 1-5)
 - o Confidence of the King (v. 6-8)
- Psalm 21—"Answered prayer ought to be acknowledged with fervent praise."—Wiersbe
 - o David's <u>Celebration</u> for <u>Past</u> Victories (v. 1-7)
 - David's <u>Confidence</u> in <u>Future</u> Victories (v. 8-12)
