The Nature of God

"⁵ This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that **God is light**, and in him is no darkness at all."

God is light = God is **holy**

"⁶ If we <u>say</u> we have fellowship with him while we <u>walk</u> in darkness, we <u>lie</u> and do not practice the truth."

Just because someone "professes" something doesn't mean that they truly "possess" it.

If you live willfully/habitually in a <u>pattern</u> of sin you do not know God.

"8 If we say <u>we have no sin</u>, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us..."

"¹⁰ If we say <u>we have not sinned</u>, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us."

Some will...

- **Ignore** their sins
- Redefine their sins Conceal their sins
- Blame their sins

The more you <u>walk</u> in the light the more <u>aware</u> you become of your own sin.

• **Justify** their sins

"⁹ If we <u>confess</u> our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Those who know God <u>confess</u> their sins honestly.

"confess" -homologeo

"homo" = same "lego" = to say

"to say the same"

- Advocate (parakletos = comforter)-Defense Attorney

- Atonement (propitiation = to appease the wrath of God)
