Seven Similarities of the Seven Letters

- Each letter starts with the same salutation—a special title for Jesus.
- 2. Each letter is addressed to the "angel" of each church.
- Each letter opens with an omniscient knowing of what's going on in the church.
- Each letter addresses either a compliment, a complaint, or both

Seven Similarities of the Seven Letters

- Each letter references something about Jesus' <u>Second</u> Coming.
- Each letter closes with the statement—
 "He who has <u>ears</u> to hear, let him hear"
- 7. Each letter closes with a <u>promise</u> or <u>reward</u> to those who "overcome."
