Psalm 57, 58, 59

- All three psalms are to be sung to the tune/melody of "Do Not Destroy"
- In all three psalms there is some source of trouble that David is having to endure or overcome

- Context: David is fleeing from King Saul as a fugitive (1 Samuel 19)

- Context: David fleeing to the city of Gath and acting like a madman. (1 Samuel 21)
