Psalm 77

- Written by "Asaph"
- Background unknown
- OUTLINE:
 - Asaph's Pain (v. 1-10)
 - Asaph's Praise (v. 11-20)

Psalm 78

- Written by "Asaph"
- The psalmist highlights past mistakes made by God's people in hopes that they wouldn't repeat the same failures.
- Second longest psalm behind Ps. 119
- OUTLINE:
 - The Command to Teach (v: 1-7)
 - The Consequence of Transgression (v. 8-72)
