- Faith in God's faithfulness
- Our walk with God is not merely self-minded, but community minded.

- **Scene 7: Waters of Meribah - Unbelief yields strife v. 32-33**
- **Scene 8: Canaan - Unbelief yields corruption v. 34-46**
