- " 1 Simeon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ."

<u>Simeon</u> (Hebrew name) = God hears / listens <u>Peter</u> (Converted name) = Grk. *petros;* little stone / rock

There is life-changing power in the gospel of Jesus Christ.

- WRITTEN BY: Apostle Peter
- " <sup>1</sup> Simeon Peter, a <u>servant</u> and <u>apostle</u> of Jesus Christ."

servant (doulos) = willing slave (identity)
apostle = sent forth one (position of leadership)

Our <u>identity</u> in Christ must always precede our <u>calling</u> in this life.

- WRITTEN BY: Apostle Peter
- WRITTEN TO: same people as 1 Peter (2Pet. 3:1)

"to those who have obtained a faith of <u>equal</u> <u>standing</u> with ours..."

All true believers have received a faith of <u>equal</u> standing.

- WRITTEN BY: Apostle Peter
- WRITTEN TO: same people as 1 Peter (2Pet. 3:1)
- WRITTEN WHEN: 65AD (about 1 year after writing 1 Pet. and 2 years before martyred)
- WRITTEN WHY: to expose and combat false teaching within the church.

"2 May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord."

"knowledge" *epignosis* –13x's (A personal <u>experiential</u> relationship with God.)

Peter's desire in 2 Peter is that you would "grow in the knowledge" of the Lord Jesus. (3:18)

Found in a PERSON (v. 1)

"1 Simeon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who have <u>obtained</u> a FAITH of equal standing with ours by the <u>righteousness</u> of our God and Savior <u>Jesus Christ</u>..."

The Great Exchange—our sin for his righteousness.

(Verse 1-4)

- Found in a PERSON (v. 1)
- Grants us divine POWER (v. 3)

"
His divine <u>power</u> has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness..."

Saving faith grants us power to live a life of <u>holiness</u> and <u>godliness</u>.

(Verse 1-4)

- Found in a PERSON (v. 1)
- Grants us divine POWER (v. 3)
- Involves precious / great PROMISES (v. 4a)

"<sup>4</sup> by which he has granted to us his precious and very great <u>promises</u>..."

God's promises are precious and very great because God can and will fulfill them.

(Verse 1-4)

- Found in a PERSON (v. 1)
- Grants us divine POWER (v. 3)
- Involves precious / great PROMISES (v. 4a)
- Makes us PARTAKERS (v. 4b)

"...so that through them you may become <u>partakers</u> of the <u>divine nature</u>..."
